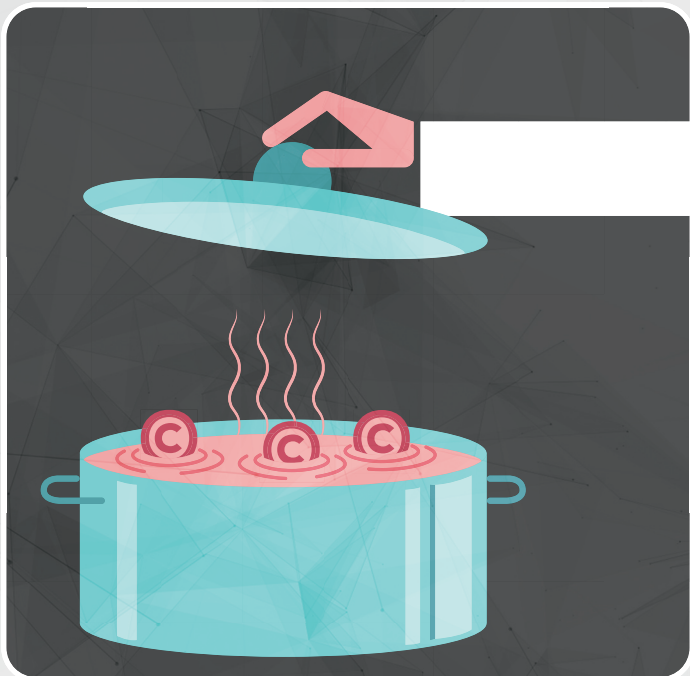




MYTH

REALITY

If you want to use a piece of work that is still in copyright, for a purpose that is not subject to copyright exceptions, you will need to seek permission from the copyright holder.

Putting a disclaimer does not exempt you from copyright infringement.
